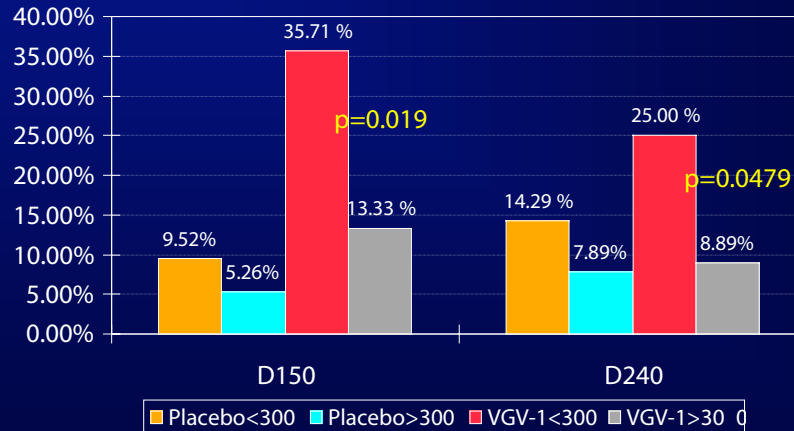


## Baseline CD4 and %Responders at D150 and D240

This chart compares the percentage of patients with a good “response” (decrease of 0.5 log or 70% in HIV viral load) during the study, but separates them by how strong their immune systems’ were at the study’s start using a measurement called CD4.

As you can see from the chart, patients who were on VGV-1 with lower CD4 counts (the red columns) were much more likely to have a good response than placebo patients (orange and blue columns). Patients on VGV-1 that were healthier (grey columns) also did not do as well as these sicker patients that received VGV-1.

While this needs more study to explain, this seems to indicate that VGV-1 works better on sicker patients than healthier patients.
